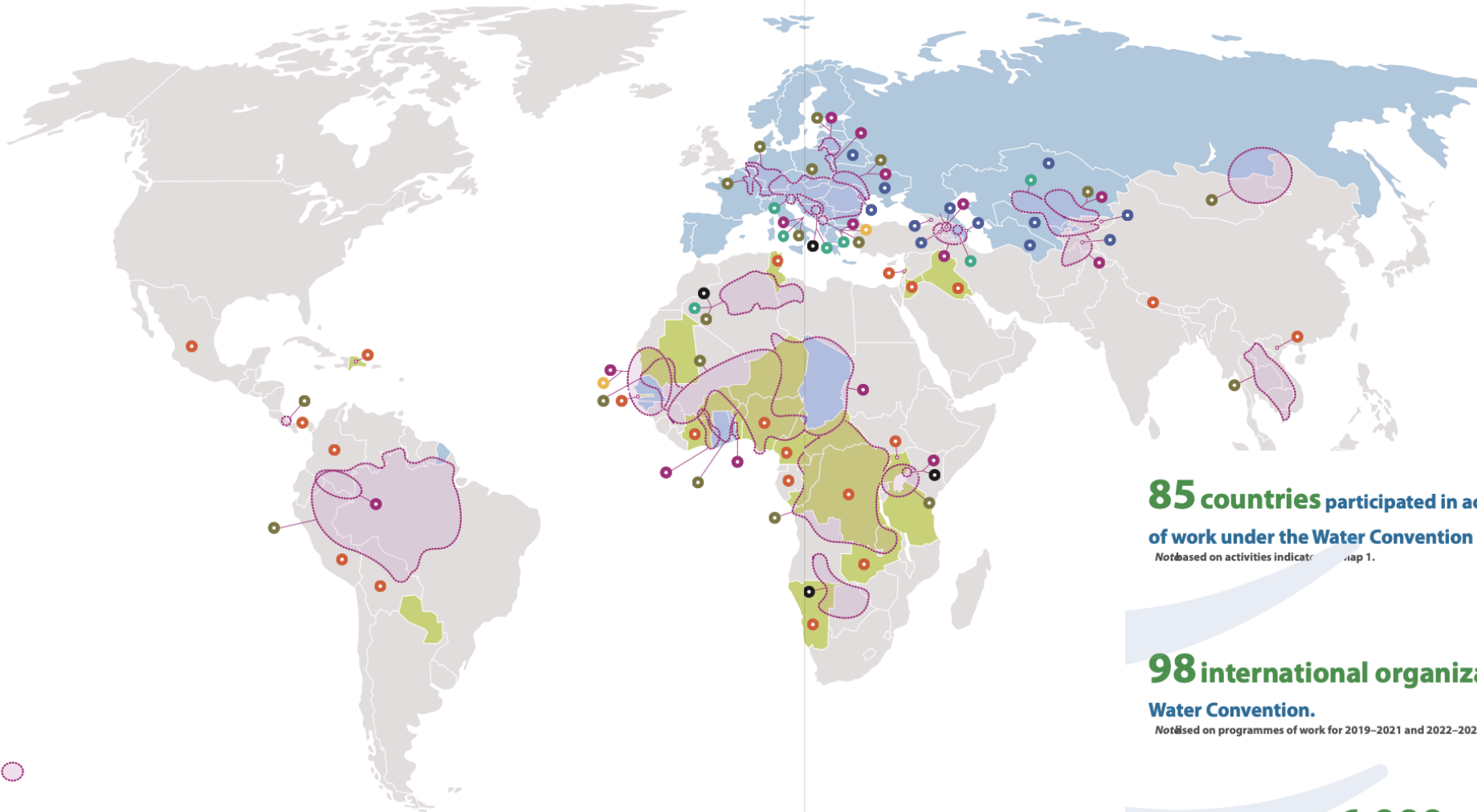


Framing Tools for Future Cross Border Collaboration



● Identify, assess and communicate the benefits of transboundary water cooperation



85 countries participated in activities on the ground under the programmes of work under the Water Convention in the period 2015–2022.

Not based on activities indicated in map 1.

98 international organizations and NGOs are partners to the Water Convention.

Not based on programmes of work for 2019–2021 and 2022–2024.

In 2011–2021, about **6,000 experts** were trained on international water law, water management, climate change adaptation, the nexus approach, dam safety and other areas through the capacity-building activities led by the Water Convention.

Destruction of Amur falcons

- 120,000–140,000 Amur falcons were being hunted and killed in Nagaland, India, every year.
- One of the longest migrations among all birds—a staggering 22,000 km annually. From China and to Northeast India and Bangladesh and eventually over the Indian Ocean to reach Africa: a 2-3 day non-stop flight covering over 3,000 km over the sea.





China – vs – India

- In November 2020, China announced plans for hydropower construction on the section of the Brahmaputra closest to India, triggering strong responses from the Indian side
- Indian pundits have accused China of “weaponizing” water and using water for political and strategic leverage over India.
