- That Nature is inclusive of all human beings. The rights of nature and human rights can, and should, be mutually reinforcing.
- That trust, compassion, and collaboration across borders, cultures, and generations are the true currency of a flourishing civilisation.

Therefore, we commit to:

- Building regenerative and resilient bioregions, cities and rural areas, food and other industrial systems, and energy and other infrastructures that sustain rather than exploit.
- Standing for openness, ethics[MOU4], democracy, and human dignity against the rise of division and autocracy.
- Nurturing communities of belonging, empathy, and creativity so that all may thrive.
- Acting with urgency, because the time for half-measures has passed.
