■ WHY

- Pervasive dissemination of a **long term**, future oriented culture: the mission of Fondation 2100
- Foresight for Good: choosing desirable futures means a call for imagination, creative experience, humanity, responsibility

The GFRI Core Assessment Framework

*Foresight Readiness demands a proactive stance ...
... toward alternative futures*

The Global Foresight Readiness Index intends to **measure** fundamental capacities that characterize foresight - ready organizations:

- **Long term Foresight Awareness**, with Foresight cultural integration.
- **Foresight Preparedness, including Detection Capacity**, including the ability to systematically scan horizons and identify relevant signals of change.
- **Foresight Response Capacity**: The capability to analyze implications and develop appropriate plans.
- **Evolution Capacity in the short run**: The organizational flexibility to **transform** systems, structures, and strategies to thrive in well anticipated futures.

Two Proofs of Concept dedicated to intricate objectives in Fondation 2100 Action Plan for 2026

- **A Premium application for Organisations who would like to adopt the professional version** of the Global Foresight Readiness Index under international ICT safety, reporting and confidentiality rules
 - Improves Anticipatory Governance
 - Gives credit to Environmental / Sustainability and social accountability
 - Expands the Risks scope and description required for Listed Companies
 - Voluntary Scheme, open for co-construction,
 - No Label or Certification other than the Fondation 2100 GFRI mention under CC.
- **A serious game for beginners (Web App available on mobile devices)**
 - Measuring up to which point individuals already are future-oriented in their structuring decisions, with an appropriate scoring
 - Raising individual awareness about the benefits of Foresight Readiness
 - Harnessing the Foresight Readiness attractivity
 - Opening larger, deeper and longer views before crucial decision making/ radical Bifurcations

Examples of Qualitative and Quantitative indicators in the 10-Point Ranking Framework

1. Foresight Culture Readiness

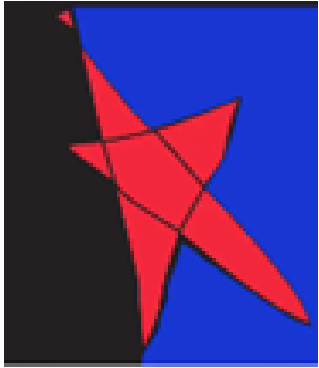
- Qualitative indicator:
 - leadership messages incorporating Foresight
 - Survey Results on receptiveness to change
- Quantitative indicator :
 - % of budget allocated to Foresight
 - number of dedicated staff

2. Temporal horizon diversity

- Qualitative indicator:
 - Analysis of strategic documents,
 - Media coverage of time horizons
- Quantitative indicator:
 - Distribution of projects by time horizon. Ex: 50% short-term, 30% medium-term, 20% long-term

How would you name a Serious Game available for Foresight Readiness Beginners ?

- 10 questions with 5 possible answers each. User experience and results available for researchers involved in the early design.
 - 2 minutes only
 - Scoring downloadable if required
- Anonymous, with hortatory informations given by the gamer.
- Filters for analysis
- 12 languages including numerous different alphabets/ideograms
- *Diversity of cultures friendly*, simplicity of design
- Serious game *on going* multi criteria *assessment* and learning process by Foundation 2100.
